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# 1 Kampong Ayer Tour – 2 Hours

#### Overview

- Tour departs **0830** and **1330** hours. Tour commences 30 minutes earlier for hotels located outside city areas.

Kampong Ayer, one of the world's largest water villages, has hovered over the shallows of the Brunei River for at least four centuries and currently houses an estimated 30,000 people. During the 16th Century, Kampong Ayer was a bustling community of 25,000 people. It's no wonder that this labyrinth town on stilts impressed the Magellan expedition back in 1521.

Now, despite being furnished with modern facilities, the water village retains its traditional, colourful, and lively atmosphere. This tour captures the essence of a water villager's lifestyle with a home visit for tea and local cakes. Take a visit to the Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery, which comprises of five mini-galleries. The galleries display the different



facets of Kampong Ayer, beginning from the 10th century up to present day life. The exhibits also include archaeological findings, items from contemporary culture, pictures, map, and photographs.

You will be travelling in a wooden boat which is an experience of its own. Life jackets are provided.



# 2 Brunei's Proboscis Monkey Tour – 2 Hours

Proboscis Monkey

The endangered Proboscis Monkey is indigenous only to the island of Borneo. This popular tour takes you on a leisurely cruise through the mangroves in search of these illustrious primates while the guide describes the pristine nature of the Nipah Palm and Mangroves forests. Whilst searching for the Proboscis Monkey, it is not uncommon to see various birds of prey, king fishers, mangrove snakes, monitor lizards, otters, flying foxes, and even salt water crocodiles. Relax and enjoy the evening sunset and gaze at the spectacular sight of hundreds of egrets flying back to the mangrove trees before dusk.

Travelers will be provided with boat rides and an experienced guide.



# 3 City Tour – 3 Hours

Tour the city and visit the Royal Regalia Museum, the Malay Technology Museum, and the Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque.

Have a photo stop of the Water Village or popularly known as 'The Venice of The East' along the roadside. View the Istana Nurul Iman, which is the official residence of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di Pertuan of Negara Brunei Darussalam.



# 4 Bandar Splendour Tour – 4 Hours

Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque

Enjoy an eye-opening four-hour tour that unfolds parts of the Bruneian history, religion, culture, heritage, and the daily lifestyle of the local people. The tour includes a photo stop outside the Royal Palace, Istana Nurul Iman, which is the biggest residential palace in the world, and also visit the magnificently built Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque.

Get set to tour "The Venice of the East", the famous water village on breathtaking water taxi ride, and take a stroll on the houses built on stilts. Located nearby the water village, The Malay Technology Museum, a gallery which displays tributes to the lifestyle of Malays and the ethnic tribes of Brunei.

Next stop is Royal Regalia Museum, home to a collection of magnificent royal regalia, the royal chariot, gold and silver ceremonial armoury, and most importantly, His Majesty's jewel encrusted crown, which was used during his coronation in 1968.



# 5 Brunei by Night Tour – 4 Hours

#### Overview

Our departs **1830** hours. Tour commences 30 minutes earlier for hotels located outside city areas.

Enjoy a scrumptious local Bruneian cuisine for dinner then experience the magical Bandar Seri Begawan night tour with photo stop outside the iconic Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque. Then visit the daily night market called "Tamu Gadong", where you can find a variety of local delicacies. The last stop, if time permits, will be one of the largest shopping mall in Brunei for some quick shopping returning to the hotel.



# 6 Brunei by Night Tour – 2 Hours

Tour departs **1830** hours. Tour commences 30 minutes earlier for hotels located outside city areas.

The first photo stop at the famous landmark, Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque then head to the Istana Nurul Iman before going to another photo stop at Jame Asr' Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque and witness one of the most magnificent mosques in Asia, with its 29 golden domes.

The tour ends at the famous night market called Tamu Gadong where you will find an assortment of food and local dishes, fresh fish and poultry grilled over open fires, usually costing BND1 – BND3 only. We recommend to try as many local delicacies as possible.

There are also stalls selling drinks, fresh vegetables, fresh fruit and even clothes and accessories.



# **7** Oil Discovery Tour – 5 Hours

#### Overview

Our departs **0800** hours. Tour commences 30 minutes earlier for hotels located outside city areas.

Drive through the Tutong District while making your way to the coastal oil-producing town of Seria. Past the oil refinery and liquefied natural gas plants, you will arrive at the Oil & Gas Discovery Centre for an educational tour of Brunei's oil and gas industry. For a light lunch, stop by a local restaurant, and complete the tour with stroll around Seria town.



# 8 Brunei Heritage Tour – 7 Hours

- Tour departs **0830** hours. Tour commences 30 minutes earlier for hotels located outside city areas.
- Dress appropriately, wearing non-revealing clothing and/or shorts that are below the knees

Royal Regalia Museum

Examine all things local during this full day Heritage Tour which firstly brings you to the splendour of the open markets, a busy place where Bruneians buy their daily local-made goods. Then visit the Malay Technology Museum, a gallery which displays tributes to the lifestyle of Malays and the ethnic tribes of Brunei. The Heritage Tour will also take you to the Brunei Museum that comprises of six galleries, such as the collection of Islamic Arts and many more fascinating cultural features.

Enjoy local cuisine for lunch, then continue to the Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque, one of Asia's most magnificent mosque. Next, venture to Royal Regalia Museum, which was completed in 1992 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee of His Majesty the Sultan. This astounding building is filled with the Royal Regalia used during The Sultan's Coronation, the Crown itself, the replica of the throne room, and numerous gifts from state dignitaries.

Take a boat ride to Kampong Ayer's house visit where you can observe the local lifestyle. Take a piece of Brunei with you for family and friends back home and pick up a souvenir at the The Mall, Gadong. Lastly, end the day with a photo stop at the Istana Nurul Iman, the world's largest residential palace!



#### 9 **Heritage Drive Tour – 2 Hours**

Overview



This is a stay-in-coach tour

Brunei's past and present are combined in this comprehensive city tour, driving you to Brunei's famous places of interest. The tour starts with a drive past the various landmarks in the city centre from Taman Haji Sir Muda Omar Ali Saifuddien to Darussalam palace. Learn Brunei's collection of Malay and Muslim heritage and the national history collection as we drive past some of the museums. Passing by the tombs of Brunei ancient rulers before the final stop at the Kota Batu Archaeological Park.



# 10 Tasek Merimbun – 4 Hours

#### Overview

- Tour Departs 0600 hours
- © Excellent for birders and macro photography enthusiasts



The unique black water lake known as Tasek Merimbun is the largest lake in Brunei. Two rivers, Sungai Meluncur and Sungai Bang Oncom, flow into the lake. The waters from the two rivers are almost black because they flow through swamp forests full of peat on their way to the lake. Tasek Merimbun naturally has an unusual S-shape. There is a small island in the center, which is accessible by way of a timber walkway. This is a good place for picnicking around the lake, exploring the forest, wildlife spotting and bird watching.



# 11 Chasing Waterfall – 6 Hours

#### Overview

- (1) Tour Departs **0630 hours**



There are more than 40 waterfalls in Teraja, spread out across hilly terrain and separated by rocky streams, making proper hiking gear and boots a must. Easy hikes and wading through cool, refreshing waters are the perfect introduction for nature enthusiasts to Brunei's pristine, natural wealth.

Apart from the astonishing waterfalls that situated in the region, a venue that seems to be swallowed by the dense jungle is the Teraja Longhouse. A place that seems to be forgotten by many in the current fast-paced world and is living in its momentum sits just at the location. A trip down to the venue will allow you to experience a distinctive lifestyle that is scarcely in practice in the present world. On Sunday, special cultural performance may also be requested at an additional cost that will enable visitors to learn more about the age-old culture.



# 12 Thursday Market & Dusun Cultural Experience – 8 hours

Overview

(1) Tour Departs **0615 hours.** 



The Homestay Alai Gayuh Anak Pulau (HAGAP) is located deep in the pristine forest of the Tutong district, isolated from the nearest residential area by approximately 20 minutes' drive, just like Dusun houses in the past and located on a manmade lake. Not to worry, there is modern plumbing available in a separate building on land with separate bathrooms for men and women.

From the deck of the house, guests can comfortably bird-watch the many species that live in the area as they fly by and go about their daily lives. Guests will be guided into the forest, where they can look at all the different species of trees and plants that exist in the forest in abundance, far from the interference of people. If one is lucky, they can also catch glimpses of the much bigger wild animals in the area, including mammals such as gibbons, wild boars and deer as well as reptiles such as snakes and monitor lizards.



# 13 Temburong Longhouse Excursion Tour – 6 Hours

Overview

Tour Departs 0830 hours.



#### Note

It is advisable if guests request to provide gifts to the Ibans to express their gratitude

This tour is a comprehensive tour on the history, culture and tradition of the people of Temburong. A reflection on the olden days of Brunei, the tour will also showcase the belief and traditions of the native Iban people and how they all live under one roof.

Pick-up from the hotel at 0830hrs and proceed to the Bumbungan 12 Jetty. Board a local public speedboat for a scenic boat ride through mangrove-lined water-ways; you may be able to see some of the local wildlife along the way. Upon arrival to the charming town of Bangar, enjoy some light refreshments, like Wajid Temburong (a sweet glutinous rice snack folded in leaves) at the market (Tamu), a place where locals buy their daily products and fruits.

Then followed by the visit to one of the Iban longhouse. Along the way you will be mesmerized by the beautiful countryside of Temburong District. See the local houses, schools, and natural landscape surrounding the district. Upon your arrival, your guide and host will brief you about the longhouse history, the Iban culture and their way of life.

You will learn how to cook a traditional dish of the tribe people with chicken and glutinous rice in a bamboo. To further enhance guests' experience of the tribe, pipe blowing and mat weaving will be demonstrated and you will get to try at both activities.

Trek through the forest along the river to experience how the Iban tribes hunt and survive.

Lastly, lunch will be served with Iban style cooking. Like the Ibans, you will sit on the floor to eat your meals. Depart to Bangar and return back to the capital via the local speedboat.



# 14 Ulu-Ulu National Park Resort - Day Tour



Canopy Walk in Temburong

The journey begins from your respective hotel. Pickup from the hotel to Bumbungan 12 Jetty for the Ulu Ulu Resort Day Trip tour.

As a brief introduction, The National Park is situated within the Batu Apoi Forest reserves and lies at the confluence of the Temburong and Belalong Rivers. Covering an area of 50,000 hectares, only 100 hectares is designated as park visitation area, thus the park is a safe haven for flora and fauna. There is no human or modern encroachment in this area except for the field research centre in Ulu Belalong. The biodiversity of this area is one of the best in the world.

The journey to the national park itself is an adventure where you go pass winding river tributaries lined with Nipah palms and mature mangrove trees. Upon reaching Bangar town, we proceed by land to Batang Duri jetty where you will be transported to the national park using long boat called "temuai" driven by skilled locals manoeuvring pass several rapids. When we reach the Ulu Ulu Resort, we will pass by the beautiful Villas with elegant accommodation. We will then proceed to the Club Lounge for Welcome Drink while viewing



some exhibits and specimens from the National Park, and take a walk to the nearby, Souvenirs, Gifts & Sundries shop.

After doing these activities, we proceed to the Dining hall at Valley Café for Lunch.

#### **Option A: The Canopy Walk**

The Canopy Tower itself, requires approx. 850 steps going uphill, you will reach the canopy tower which consist of 5 aluminum structure, averaging 40 – 50 meters in height.

This activity is only recommended for those who are physically fit, healthy, and not afraid of heights. Please note that from 930hrs to 430hrs, the weather is hot and humid and trekking to the canopy tower is very taxing and not much can be seen except experiencing the rainforest environment. The best time to go to the canopy is sunrise and sunset time; this can only be done with an overnight stay.

#### Option B: Stay and Relax at the resort

Ulu Ulu Resort sits on the edge of the 50,000 hectares of pristine rainforest. This location has observation decks, areas where you can relax on the hammocks, good range of flowers, trees, herbs and other plants that



	attract birds, insects, and butterflies, for you to observe or take a photograph. If time permits, you will have the chance to water tube in the Temburong River (Note: only available for those who can swim) and trek to the mini water fall. After which, you can enjoy a hot shower at Ulu Ulu Resort.
1230 hrs	One (1) bath towel will be provided per person. (Free flow of coffee and tea. The resort's drinking water is pumped from the river and goes through a 5-stage particle filtration and a final stage through a drinking water filtration. The water is not chlorinated).  Local lunch will be served at Valley Café
1330 hrs	Depart Ulu Ulu Resort National Park by longboat and proceed the journey back to Bandar Seri Begawan (B.S.B.)
1400 hrs	Arrive Kg Batang Duri, proceed by road back to Bangar
1430 hrs	Arrive Bangar and board the speedboat for return trip to Bandar town
1530 hrs	Arrive Bandar town, transfer to your hotel

You will also visit the Malay Technology Museum which has galleries on the Malays, ethnic tribes and their lifestyles. There is a short photo stop of the magnificent Istana Nurul Iman, the largest residential palace in the world from Damuan Park. Lastly, you will take an enjoyable boat ride on the Kampong Ayer, one of the world's largest water villages and visit a privately owned house to enjoy local delicacies.

Lunch at a local restaurant



In the evening, pick up from the hotel's lobby for **Brunei by Night Tour – 4 Hours** with dinner. Proceed for a scrumptious local dinner. After dinner, experience the magical Bandar Seri Begawan night with photo stops outside the iconic Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah mosque, then visit the daily night market where you can experience the "local" food scene and taste all the local food or snacks. The last stop, if time permits, will be one of the largest shopping mall in Brunei where you will have a quick shopping before returning to the hotel.



modern economy. Kampong Ayer is a unique treasure belonging to the Bruneians and the historical reminders over the centuries are exhibited in 5 mini-galleries within this building. Then take a walk along the plank walk at the village to visit one of the local houses where they will be served with light local refreshment. A lot of photo opportunity along the way.

Guests will also have an opportunity for photo takings at the mini wedding stage in the house. Stop at the spectacular Sultan Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque.



Visit the Malay Technology Museum which has galleries on the Malays, ethnic tribes and their lifestyles. Have a photo stop at the tomb



of Sultan Bolkiah who was the fifth ruler of Islamic Brunei and his reign is known as the nation's golden age.

Proceed to a jetty for a boat ride at the Water Village to visit one of the local houses where they will be served with light local refreshment. Shopping at The Mall, Gadong. Lunch served at a local restaurant. Dzuhur prayer at Jame' Asr Hassanil Bolkiah Mosque. This is one of the most magnificent mosques in Asia with 29 golden domes.

### Day 3

In the morning, pick up from the hotel's lobby for day tour with lunch served at a local restaurant. Visit to open market, a place where locals buy their daily products, some 'ready to eat' food, handicrafts, local herbs and medicinal plants. Visit to Royal Regalia Museum which is home to a collection of royal regalia, royal chariot, gold and silver ceremonial armoury. Visit to Brunei Arts and Handicraft Centre where local arts & handicrafts such as weaving, silverware, krises, basketry, songkok, and others are being displayed and for sales. Visit to Jabatan Mufti Exhibition Hall where you can see the collection of more than 300 hand written Al Quran (the holy book of Islam) where some of them already more than 100 years old. Walking stick and the prayer beads can also be seen in this gallery. Lunch served at a local restaurant. Pass by the Legislative Council Building, Ministry of Finance.

# **Transportation and Traveling Time**



Ulu-Ulu National Park Resort is located within the Ulu Temburong National Park, getting there requires boat rides in speedboat from Bandar Seri Begawan (B.S.B.) to Temburong, and then by 'Temuai' longboat to Ulu-Ulu National Park Resort.

The boarding time for the public speedboat and the duration of the longboat ride are subject to change. For the public speedboat, it depends on the speedboat availability and the longboat ride depends on the water level. In the case that the water level is low, it might need you to push the longboat - enjoy the adventure!:)

All possible details would be provided to our third party operators and assist them to provide the service to our level of standard and expectation but sometimes beyond our control, the services may not be to our full request and may cause delay. The situation where there is a delay and clients wish to change to private basis will be subjected to cash payment and the amount will depend on availability of vehicle and tour assistance.

We consider the safety of our guests as one of our top priority: When in speedboat: Guests must stay in their seats especially when the speedboat is making turns. When in Longboat 'Temuai': Guests must wear lifejacket at all times, to keep your hand within the 'temuai' longboat and to stay at their seats.

Tourists going to Ulu Ulu Resort are requested /recommended to bring along their actual passport in a water proof bag in case of unavailability of speedboat, there is the option of overland (going pass Limbang, Sarawak) and will cost an additional of B\$100 (cash payment) limited to max 5 persons per vehicle for this 1 way transfer to be paid directly to our company. Guests are to check on their visa and to make sure that your passport are valid to take this journey and to re-enter Brunei.

Tourists are highly recommended to have one day buffer when visiting Ulu Ulu National Park Resort. If you have a flight on the same day, we recommend you not to do the day trip. If you are on an overnight package, please make sure your flight is in the late afternoon of the days you are leaving the resort.



Tourists are reminded that we are not responsible or liable for any compensation for any delay caused as this tour may have delays caused by unforeseen circumstances such as weather or lack of speed boats but is a rare occurrence (it happened once in our 6 years of operation!!) but nonetheless, we like to always bring awareness and have preparation for any incident as we like to make sure our clients are well prepared and enjoy the experience of our tour packages in whatever circumstances.

### **Important Notes**

This is an adventure tour which is highly **NOT** recommended to those with walking disabilities or which require aid to walk such as wheelchair etc., height phobia, problem in balancing, heart problem & medical problems, who do recent operation before the date of the tour, pregnant ladies and child under 7 years old due to the resort is not yet equipped with child's facilities.
