

# Singapore's Vaccinated Travel Lane with Brunei

From 8 September 2021, Guests who travel via the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) from Brunei to Singapore are required to:

## STEP 01

Be **fully vaccinated** with 2 doses of approved COVID-19 vaccine and **depart at least 14 days after** receiving your second dose of COVID-19 vaccination



## STEP 02

Obtain **Exit Approval from Brunei's Prime Ministers' Office (PMO)** through the Travel Portal:  
<http://www.pmo.gov.bn/travelportal/>



## STEP 03

- Apply for a **Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)** at <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/apply-now> and **prepay** for your post-arrival **Day 3 and Day 7 COVID-19 PCR test** at point of application\*
- Meet other requirements from Singapore** of the Vaccination Travel Lane (VTL) at <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg>



## STEP 04

Take a **COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test** result within **48-hours** before the scheduled day of departure



Result of the pre-departure PCR test should be **negative**

## STEP 05

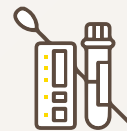
Upon check-in at Brunei International Airport, please **present passport, exit approval from Brunei's Prime Ministers' Office (PMO), vaccination certificate, negative COVID-19 PCR test report, a valid Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) and the Trace Together app** (downloaded and registered)



Failure to provide all required documentation will result in guests not permitted to travel

## STEP 06

**Undergo COVID-19 PCR test upon arrival at Changi International Airport.** Guests should register and make payment for their on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test prior to their departure

Note: This is a separate payment from Day 3 & Day 7 post-arrival COVID-19 PCR test

## STEP 07

You must stay **self-isolated in your declared accommodation in Singapore** until you receive a negative test result which will likely be available within 24 hours and to **adhere to the strict health protocols of Singapore**



Once a negative test result is received, you may leave your declared accommodation and go about your activities in Singapore

## STEP 08

On **day 3 & day 7** post-arrival, you must take **another COVID-19 PCR Test** at designated clinics in Singapore



Instructions will be emailed to you upon arrival in Singapore

## NOTE

### FOR SHORT-TERM VISITORS:

**Download and activate TraceTogether app.** This must be downloaded, registered and presented upon check-in at Brunei International Airport. **Activate the app** immediately after clearing immigration at Changi International Airport. **Keep app data for 21 consecutive days** and upload app data if requested by Singapore Ministry of Health



- Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and Diplomats do not need to apply for a Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)** to travel to Singapore under the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL), as they can return to Singapore without the need for entry approval. **However, Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents are still required to adhere to the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) requirements.**

- Applications for the Air Travel Pass (ATP) for short-term visitors travelling from Brunei Darussalam to Singapore is suspended with immediate effect. This will be replaced with **Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)\* in which application is open from 1 September 2021 for entry into Singapore from 8 September 2021.**
