

# Singapore's Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL)

## Requirements on travelling via the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) from Brunei to Singapore

Guests who wish to travel via the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) from Brunei to Singapore are required to:

### Applying



- Have remained in Brunei Darussalam in the last 14 days before departure and **be fully vaccinated** with the full regime<sup>(1)</sup> of an approved WHO (EUL) COVID-19 vaccine



- **Obtain Exit Approval** from Brunei's Prime Ministers' Office (PMO) through the Travel Portal:

- Apply for a **Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)** at <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/apply-now>

### Before Departure / At Check-In



- Take a COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test or a professionally administered Antigen Rapid Test (ART) **within 2 days** before departure for Singapore.

Children aged 2 and below are exempted from this pre-departure PCR COVID-19 test



- Upon check-in at Brunei International Airport, please present:

- **Passport**
- **Exit approval** from Brunei's Prime Ministers' Office (PMO)
- **A valid Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP)**
  - **Proof of vaccination status** through the BruHealth App<sup>^</sup>
  - **Negative COVID-19 PCR test or professionally administered ART** result taken within 2 days before departure
  - **Trace Together App** downloaded and registered

<sup>^</sup>Brunei issued vaccination yellow booklet is not accepted as proof of vaccination

Failure to provide all required documentation will result in guests not being permitted to travel

### Upon Arrival



- Undergo a COVID-19 PCR test upon arrival at Changi International Airport and stay self-isolated in your declared accommodation in Singapore until a **negative test result** is received

- Be sure to **register and make payment** for your on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test before departure at <https://safetravel.changiairport.com/>

Children aged 2 and below are exempted from this on-arrival PCR COVID-19 test

- Travellers will be required to **undergo a supervised self-swab COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Tests (ART)** on Day 3 and Day 7 of their arrival in Singapore at **Quick Test Centres (QTCs) or Combined Test Centres (CTCs)**. View FAQ on this requirement [here](#)
- Travellers will also be required to undergo self-administered COVID-19 ARTs using **self-procured ART kits** on Days 2, 4, 5 and 6 of their arrival in Singapore. This is in addition to the supervised ARTs on Days 3 and 7.

### Things to note:

- **For short term visitors, download and install the TraceTogether App.**



The app must be **downloaded, registered, and presented at Brunei International Airport upon check-in**. Activate the app as soon as you clear immigration at Changi International Airport.

Keep app data for 21 days and upload app data if the Singapore Ministry of Health requests it.

- Children aged 12 and below in the calendar year (i.e. in the year 2021, those born on or after the year 2009), regardless of vaccination status, will be eligible to travel if accompanied by a fully vaccinated Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) traveller and must comply with all other Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) requirements.

They are not required to apply for a Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP).

- Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, and Diplomats **do not need to apply** for a Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) to travel to Singapore under the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL), as they can return without requiring entry approval.

However, Singapore Citizens and permanent residents must adhere to the Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) requirements.

<sup>(1)</sup> Received the full regimen of an approved WHO EUL Vaccines from a specific manufacturer (i.e. two (2) doses except for the Janssen vaccine), met the minimum dose interval period and arrive in Singapore at least two (2) weeks after the full regimen.
